## Biker duo on world tour arrive in Doha

The duo have covered 12,000km to reach Doha on a short stopover en route to Dubai from where they will set across to Iran to continue their trip via Pakistan, India, Myanmar, Thailand, Vietnam, China and Russia-Vladivostok from where they are planning to sail back to the West.

During their two-year journey they will carry out various projects helping children dependent on social welfare, those with special needs and orphans by visiting their shelters and providing aid and diagnostic equipment directly to the institutions' officials.

The trip is being funded by selling every driven kilometre for 0.10 euro.
